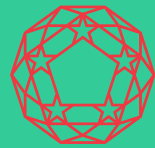

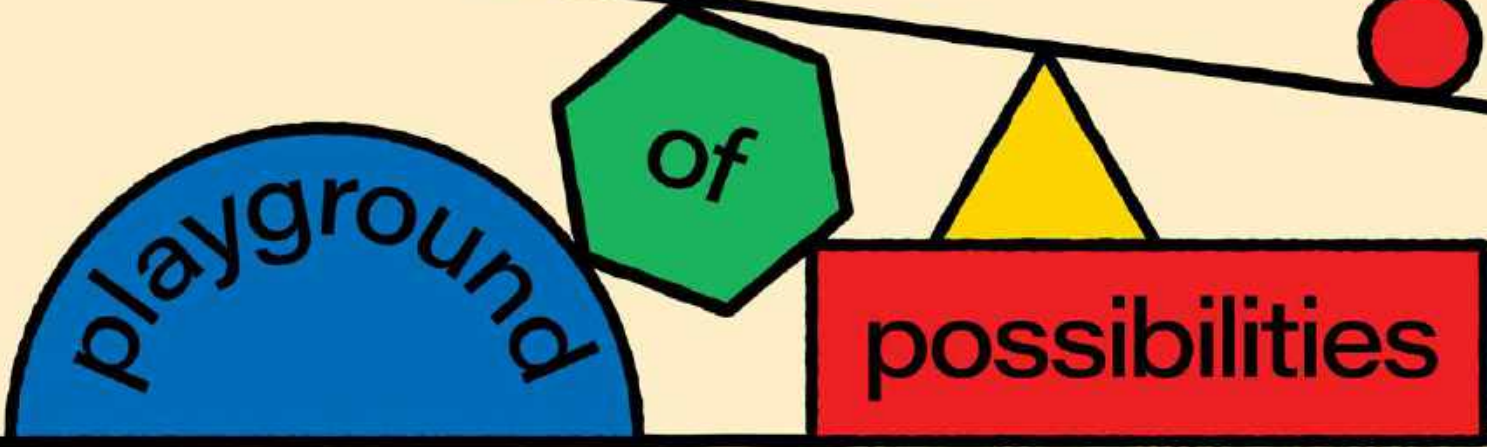

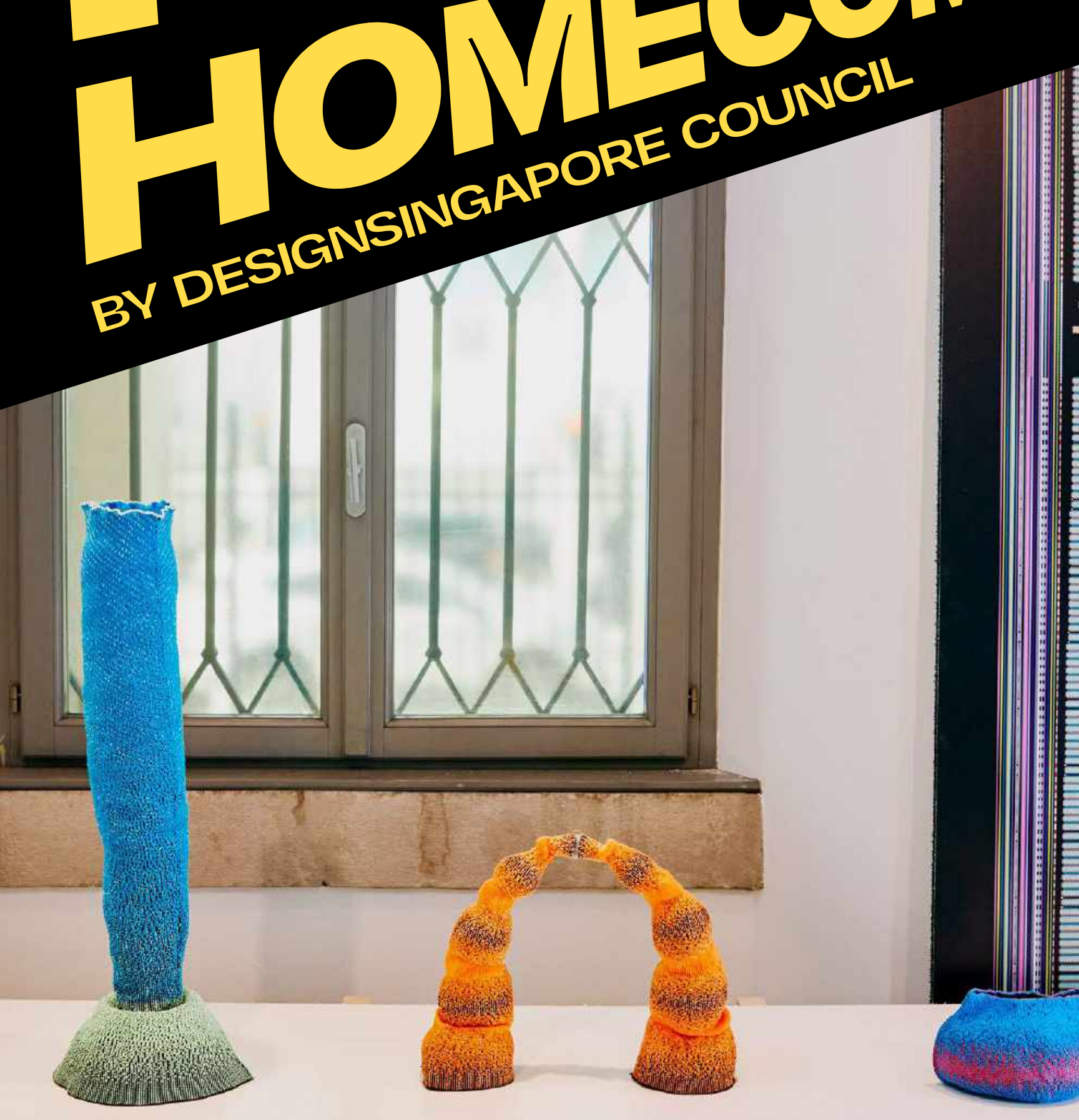

Visualization of computer code created for
additively 3D-knitting
The 3D knitted experiments were created using a
computer-aided design (CAD) knitting machine.
The automated knitting machine is capable of
constructing multi-layered and complex textile forms
in one continuous piece.
Working closely with Quik by Holo, a creative coder
at Singapore University of Technology and Design,
Trihan explored combinations of materials with
different characteristics. Thermoplastic, which softens
when subjected to heat, was used together with
common cotton yarn, to create 3D forms with
different degrees of rigidity. The color gradient
the pieces indicate a transition in materiality.
The resulting forms are self-standing objects
and plastic nature.

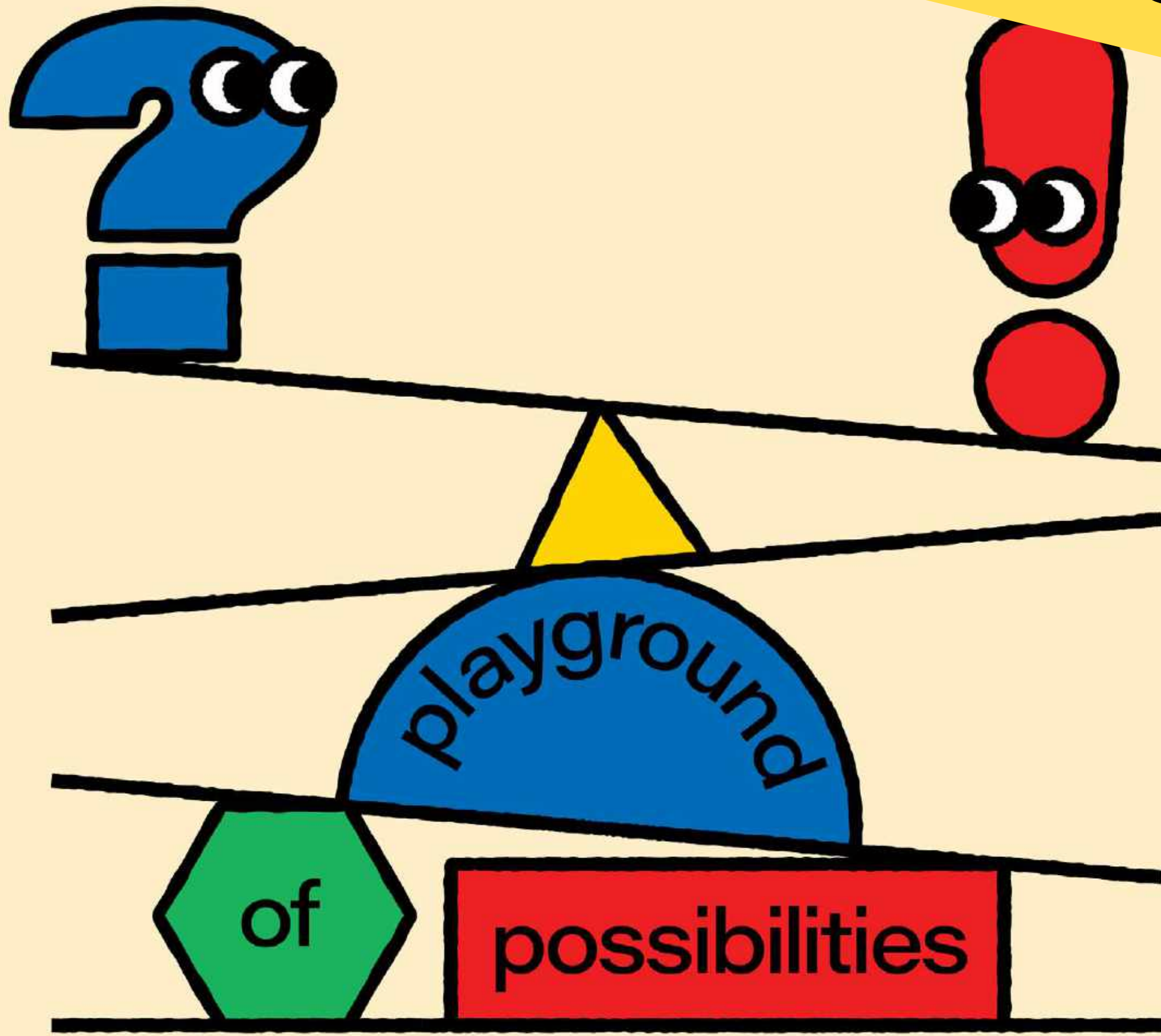

This specially commissioned interactive exhibition features some of the best examples of this ethos in practice – from environments to graphics, products, services, and experiences. Some will be new concepts and initiatives, while others will be functioning prototypes of emerging objects and technologies. These will work to emphasize possible connections between inclusion, emotion, and technology through design.

The installation will include experiential demonstrations of inclusive design in five areas: The Emotions, Fun, The Senses, Care, and Social Life and Interaction.

Exhibition curators Ong Ker-Shing and Joshua Comaroff of Lekker Architects will also unveil a new game that encapsulates this concept.
